Notes for teachers

Read the poems with the children making sure they have picked up on the rhythm and rhyme in the first one. The final question ask pupils to draw a picture – it is important that this should reflect only the poem and not any other seasonal ideas, i.e. an autumn picture should show geese flying but should not show squirrels preparing to hibernate.
