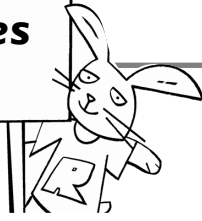

Notes for teachers

For the questions that ask pupils to explain their understanding of the text, they should make their answers as detailed as possible. Question 1 refers to verse 4. Pupils may need to be reminded that this is in fact the first verse of this text. The second question requires pupils to write 5 lines of the poem and ideally these should be presented as shown in the text. In tackling the final question pupils should show that they have an understanding of the phrase 'started a trend' within their answer.
